

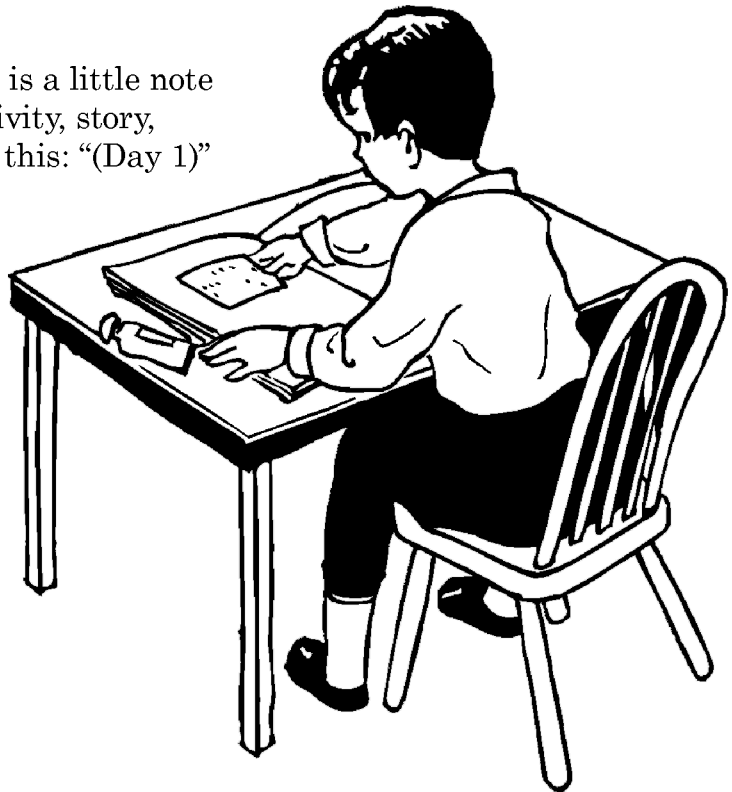
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Children's Bible Activities, Stories, and Poems

Instructions

1. This book is for children ages 4-12 and is to be used along with the *Family Bible Lessons* book, which is written for all ages. There are 13 lessons for 13 weeks.
2. Notice the first page of this book. This is the lesson overview and it will appear at the beginning of each week's lesson. It is divided into four parts. The **top left** corner gives the Bible lesson number, title, references, and a hymn that can be used all through the week while you are studying this lesson. The **top right** corner tells about the nature topic. The **bottom left** states the character quality and its definition. The **bottom right** gives the verse(s) to be memorized.*
3. The page after the lesson overview is the record page. There will be one after every lesson overview. This is where the children are to keep a record of each day during the week that they study their lesson and say their memory verse. This helps build a habit of consistent study and Scripture memorization.
4. At the bottom of most of the pages is a little note that says the day in which the activity, story, or poem is to be used. It looks like this: "(Day 1)"
The day specified corresponds with the day listed in the *Family Bible Lessons* book. For each day there are usually 2 or more pages for the children. You will notice that some activities are very simple. These are for the young children while the more challenging ones are for those who are older. The stories and poems are for all!
