4. **Describe what happened to the site Mt. Moriah.** (Pages 34-36)
5. **Why did Israel lose sight of the significance of this simple sacrifice?** (Because of slavery they were deprived of the privilege of worship) **What did God do for them?** (Brought them out of Egypt)
