- 2. How was the candlestick made?** (Beaten into shape by the workman's hammer)
- 3. What did John see in the first apartment in heaven?**
(Revelation 1:12)
- 4. What were the seven candlesticks representative of that John saw?** (Seven churches)
- 5. What does the number seven denote in the Bible?** (Complete)
- 6. What does the seven branch candlestick holding the seven lamps represents?** (The church of God)
- 7. Write out from memory Ephesians 2:10. Copy I Peter 4:12.**
- 8. How long was the lamp on the earthly sanctuary to be kept burning?** (Leviticus 24:2)
- 9. Who only was permitted to light the lamps in the earthly sanctuary?** (High Priest) **How often did he do this?**
