1. **Where was the table of showbread located in the holy place?** (Northside)
2. **Describe the table of showbread.** (Exodus 25:23-30)
3. **On each Sabbath day the Levites prepared what for the table of showbread? (12 loaves) Describe how they were made.** (I Chronicles 9:32; Leviticus 24:5-8; I Samuel 21:3-6; Matthew 12:3-4)
4. **What happened to the bread during the week? What became of it at the end of the week?** (It lay on the table until removed and eaten by the priests – Leviticus 24:9)
5. **On what day were all the services connected with the table of showbread done?** (Sabbath)
6. **What is the lesson taught by the table of the showbread?** (Man is wholly dependent upon God for both temporal and spiritual food)
7. **Who does this table and its contents represent?** (Christ the true bread – John 6:51-53)
8. **What did God design His people should do each Sabbath day?** (Gain a fresh experience in divine things to help them meet the temptations of the week)
9. **Explain how eating the bread applies to our spiritual life.** (Page 58)
10. **Does eternal life come to the soul through forms and ceremonies? (No) Explain.** (Page 58)
11. **Write from memory your memory verses.**

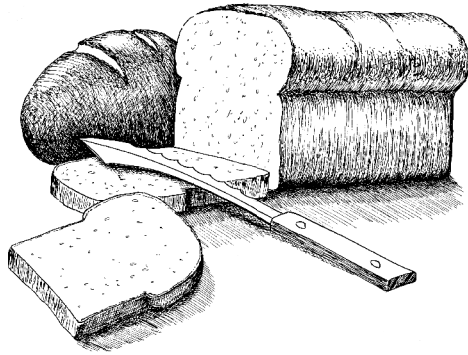
