1. **When was the offering of the first-fruits performed in the temple?** (Harvest)
2. **What did the children of Israel see as they journeyed towards Jerusalem to attend the Passover?** (Fields ripe for harvest)
3. **What had to be done before the harvesting of the field could begin?** (The first-fruits had been presented to the Lord)
4. **When was the offering of the first-fruits presented?** (Third day of the Passover feast)
5. **When was the Passover feast eaten?** (The fourteenth day of the month Abib, or Nisan)
6. **Describe this service.** (Page 109)
7. **What did this service mean?** (The waving indicated thanksgiving and praise to the Lord of the harvest)
8. **Were the first-fruits burned? Why?** (No, they were a type of the resurrected beings clad in immortality, never-more subject to death or decay)
9. **Explain the antitype of the offering of the first-fruits.** (Page 109)
10. **What can the gathering into the garner of ripened grain remind us of?** (Pages 109-110)
11. **With how much grain did the priest enter the temple?** (A handful)
12. **How many arose from the grave, when Jesus arose from the dead?** (Matthew 27:52-53)
13. **Describe the resurrection day.** (Page 111)

14. **Read the verses from Romans 8:29-30 and Ephesians 4:8 that tell about the risen saints.**
15. **Explain more about this company.** (Page 111-112)
16. **How did heaven respond to Christ and His offering of first-fruits when He entered the heavenly courts?** (Pages 112-113)
17. **What do the first three days of the Passover feast typify in the work of our Saviour?** (Broken body and shed blood)

20. **What memorial has God left His church, as the antitype of the offering of the first-fruits?** (Baptism)
