- 1. What were some of the other names for Pentecost?**
(Feast of Weeks and Feast of Harvest)
- 2. As the children of Israel journeyed toward Jerusalem to attend this feast, what did they see?** (Stubble from which had been gathered the ripened grain that lay all ready to be trodden out upon the threshing-floors)
- 3. Explain why the people were to bring free-will offerings at this time?** (Pages 116-117)
- 4. Why was this feast sometimes called the Day of the First-fruits?** (Numbers 28:26 – The children of Israel were expected to make liberal offerings at this time)
- 5. How much time did the services of the Feast of Weeks (Pentecost) occupy?** (One day)
- 6. The disciples saw only a handful of believers as a result of Christ's three and one half years of toil, but when Pentecost had fully come what happened?** (The harvest)
- 7. Explain the antitype of Pentecost.** (Pages 117-118)
- 8. Explain the work the disciples were to do in order that they might be ready for the great antitypical Feast of Harvest.** (They needed to study the Scriptures and put aside every difference)
- 9. What was the early and the latter rain?** (Joel 2:23-24; Page 119)
- 10. What did the children of Israel do in support of the cause during the antitype of the Feast of Harvest?** (Acts 2:44-45)

11. **Fill in the blanks:** “Those who enter into the spirit of the latter rain will, like the early disciples, lay all upon the altar to be used by the Lord in the grand closing work.”
12. **Say from memory II Corinthians 9:6**

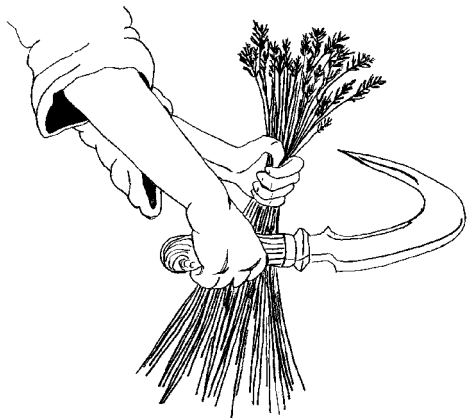
