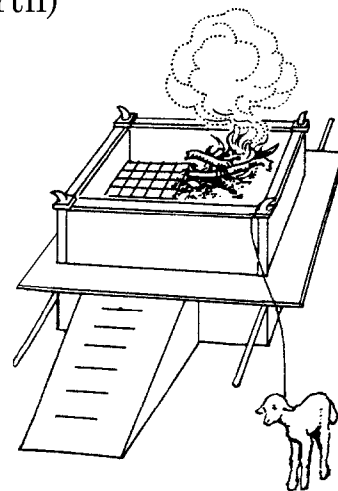


Review Questions

1. **What sanctuary service brought the individual worshipper into close touch with the Lord?** (Sin offering)
2. **Complete this verse, “If we confess our sins , he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” Where is it found in the Bible?** (I John 1:9)
3. **What is sin?** (The transgression of the law of God)
4. **Explain the reason for bringing the sin offering.** (To free the sinner from sin and to see the innocent victim die for his sins, that he might more fully comprehend how the innocent Lamb of God could offer His life for the sins of the world)
5. **If a priest sinned, what did he have to do? Why?** (Bring a bullock, showing his influence)
6. **If the sinner was a common person, what could he bring as a sin offering?** (A kid or lamb)
7. **What did the value of the animal mean?** (It told the position held by the transgressor)
8. **Where was the sin offering brought?** (To the court of the sanctuary by the door of the tabernacle of the congregation)
9. **What did the sinner then do?** (He laid his hand upon the head of the lamb, confessed his sins, and with his own hand he killed it)
10. **What did the priest do with the blood?** (Page 124)
11. **What happened to the bodies of the animals?** (Page 124; Hebrews 13:12) **How did this relate to Christ?**
12. **Explain the type and antitype of the sinner confessing his sins over the lamb.** (Pages 124-125)

13. **What happened when the blood of the sin offering was not taken into the sanctuary.** (The priest ate a portion of the flesh of the sin offering in the holy place. Leviticus 10:18)
14. **What did eating the flesh of the sin offering mean?** (Page 125)
15. **What does Leviticus 6:30 say?**
16. **The type was beautiful. Read Romans 4:7-8 and Isaiah 38:17.**
17. **Name two things that were essential in every sin offering.** (Page 126:1)
18. **After the blood was presented before the Lord, what important work did the sinner have to perform?** (With his own hands he was to remove all the fat from the different organs of the animal offered as a sin offering)
19. **What happened to the fat?** (The priest burned it upon the brazen altar)
20. **What did the fat represent?** (Psalm 37:20)
21. **Review Psalm 73:2-17 of David beholding the prosperity of the wicked and realize their end from these verses.**
22. **What is the only reason God will ever destroy a sinner?** (If he keeps sin in his character, and will not separate from it)
23. **Why was the priest waiting for the sinner to separate the fat from the offering, ready to take it as soon as it was offered to Him?** (To represent Christ our great High Priest waiting for each sinner to confess his sins and give them to Him. He then clothes the penitent with His own robe of righteousness – Isaiah 61:10)
24. **Why was the burning of the fat a sweet savor unto the Lord?** (It typified the sin consumed and the sinner saved)

25. **Name some of the other offerings a poorer person could bring.** (Two pigeons, two wild turtle doves, or some fine flour)
26. **God made provision for every sinner. Fill in the blanks:**
“The one who brought the flour, his sins shall be forgiven him, just the same as the one able to bring a bullock.”
 Remember, Jesus said “I am the Bread of Life.”
27. **Where was the blood poured in every sin offering?** (At the base of the altar of burnt offering)
28. **Explain how the ground was cursed.** (Genesis 3:17; 4:11-12)
How can this curse be removed? (Hebrews 2:11; Ephesians 1:14)
29. **Because the sins of mankind defile the earth, the blood from every sin offering was poured out on the ground. From which part of the sanctuary was the blood poured?** (Brazen altar)
What did the blood represent? (Precious blood of Christ)
30. **How did the first sin affect the earth?**
 (Failure of crops and barrenness – Genesis 3:17; 4:11-12)
31. **Write a paragraph explaining Numbers 35:33.**
 (See paragraph 3 on page 129)
32. **After the sin offering had been made, what happened to the remainder of the blood? Why?** (Poured on the ground at the base of the brazen altar in the court to represent the blood of Christ which would remove the taint of sin from the earth)
33. **Write out your memory verses.**
