

Review Questions

1. **Tell of an experience in the Bible when the drink offering was poured out. Genesis 35:10-14. Explain the meaning of this act.** (It showed his willingness to pour out his life, if necessary, for the cause of God)
2. **The drink offering was wine (unfermented grape juice). It was never drunk, but poured out before the Lord. Why was this chosen as an emblem?** (To show the life of Christ who poured out His soul and blood unto death, to redeem a lost race)
3. **What other offering accompanied the drink offering?** (Burnt offering)
4. **Where was the drink offering poured out?** (Always in the court) **Why?** (It typified things which transpired in the antitypical court, which is the earth)
5. **What reality did the pouring out of the drink offering represent?** (The Holy Spirit – Joel 2:28 and Isaiah 44:3)
6. **Explain Philippians 2:16-17.** (See page 137:1)
7. **Read the story in I Chronicles 11:17-19.**
8. **Fill in the blanks: “The drink offering was a type of Christ’s life poured out for us, and the antitype can be repeated in the life of every one who, like Paul, rejoices in being poured forth as a sacrifice and consumed upon the altar.”** (Pages 137-138)
9. **Explain Judges 9:13.** (The drink offering referred to here is said to ‘*cheer God and man*’. It is not the wine drunk at the table of friends, but wine used at the altar)
10. **The wine of the drink offering truly gladdened the heart of God and man. Like the water of Bethlehem that was poured out, what did it represent?** (The pouring out of the heart or life of the sinner before God)

11. Read the account of Hannah, her bottle of wine and her animal offering found in I Samuel 1:24; 2:1-10.
12. Write from memory Isaiah 53:12.
