

## Review Questions

1. **How was the peace-offering different from all the other offerings?** (It was the only offering, except the Passover, in which the flesh could be eaten)
2. **How often could it be offered?** (Anytime)
3. **What three things was it offered for?** (Token of thanksgiving, to confirm a vow or contract, or a voluntary offering)
4. **Give some examples from the Bible of this offering being offered.** (Exodus 24:5-8; I Chronicles 16:1-3)
5. **Describe what the individual did when offering a peace-offering.** (Laid his hands on the head of the animal, killed it, separated all the fat from the different organs)
6. **What did the priest do with the fat?** (Leviticus 7:31)
7. **What other part of the offering was given to the priest?** (Breast, right shoulder and two cheeks)
8. **Write a paragraph(s) explaining the spiritual meaning of the burning of the fat and the giving of the right breast, shoulder and two cheeks to the priest.** (Pages 154-158)
9. **What was eaten with the peace-offering?** (Unleavened cakes anointed with oil)
10. **What does the unleavened bread and oil represent?** (Sincerity and truth – I Corinthians 5:8. The Holy Spirit who brings peace to the heart)
11. **Leavened bread was also eaten with the peace-offering. What was this a token of?** (Joyfulness)
12. **Tell the story of Abraham and the peace-offering.** (Genesis 18:1-10)

13. **What rigid restrictions were there in eating the peace-offering?** (The flesh was all to be eaten upon either the first or second day – Leviticus 7:18)
14. **Fill in the blanks: “The Passover and waving of first-fruits on the third day taught the resurrection; but the priest alone entered the temple, and waved the handful of grain, in type of the resurrection of Christ; while in the peace-offering every child of God was given opportunity to show his faith in the resurrection of Christ.”** (Page 159)
15. **Explain why it was important to eat the flesh before the third day and what should be done if it was not eaten.** (Page 159:4)
16. **What would happen to the body of the sacrifice in the warm country of Palestine after the third day? (Decay) What does this teach about Christ? (Psalm 16:10)**
17. **Write from memory John 14:27.**
