

Review Questions

1. **How did the trumpet hold a special place in the life of the children of Israel?** (It was used on their joyful days and on their solemn days; and at the beginning of every month it was sounded over their burnt offerings and their peace-offerings. Page 201)
2. **What was the trumpet a reminder of?** (A reminder of the Lord their God. Page 201)
3. **How many trumpets did the Lord command Moses to make?** (Two. Page 201)
4. **What was to happen if two trumpets were blown by the priests?** (The entire congregation was to assemble at the door of the tabernacle. Page 201)
5. **What was to happen if only one trumpet was blown?** (Only the princes were to assemble. Page 202)
6. **What was the trumpet to do for the children of Israel?** (It was to be a memorial or reminder of the power of God to comfort, sustain, and protect His people. Page 202)
7. **Which day was specially set aside for the purpose of blowing the trumpets?** (What Bible reference tells of it? Numbers 29:1. Page 203)
8. **How was the trumpet used on the first day of every month?** (The sound of the trumpet was used to usher in each month and eleven sacrifices were offered. Page 203)
9. **How was the seventh month ushered in differently?** (Twenty-one sacrifices were offered. The day was kept as a ceremonial or annual sabbath, and was one of the seven days of holy convocation connected with the annual feasts. Page 203)
10. **What have some viewed the Feast of Trumpets to be a memorial of?** (A memorial of the creation of the world when “*all the sons of God shouted for joy.*” Page 204)

11. **How was the Feast of Trumpets similar to the Passover?** (They are both commemorative and typical. Page 204)
12. **What was the significance of the Feast of Trumpets in the type?** (It was a warning to all of the near approach of the solemn day of atonement. Page 204)
13. **What should be expected in the Antitype?** (A world-wide message to be given in trumpet tones, announcing the time near when the great antitypical day of atonement, the investigative judgment, would convene in the heavens. Page 204)
14. **Did this occur and, if yes, when did it occur?** (Yes. Beginning in the years 1833-1834 and extending down to 1844, such a message was given to the world in trumpet tones, announcing, "*the hour of His judgment is come.*" Page 204)
15. **What mistake did William Miller and others make when they studied Daniel 8:14?** (They failed to connect this text with the ancient typical sanctuary, but applied the term "sanctuary" to this earth, and taught that in 1844 Christ would come to the earth to cleanse it and judge the people. Page 204)
16. **Name some of the men who preached this message and what countries did they each minister to?** (William Miller in America, Edward Irving in England, Joseph Wolff in Asia. Pages 204-205)
17. **How did Paul's message differ from that given by Miller and others in 1844?** (Paul in his day preached of a "*judgment to come,*" but the burden of the message given during these years [1833-1844] was "*the hour of his judgment is come.*" Page 205)
18. **How was the misunderstanding of the object of the 1844 message similar to Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem shortly before His crucifixion?** (In both cases prophecy was fulfilled. If they had known that in a few days their Lord would hang upon that tree they would not have been able to fulfil the prophecy, for it would have been impossible for them to "*rejoice greatly.*" Likewise the message in 1843-1844 could never have been given with the power

and fullness demanded to fulfil the Antitype, if the people would had understood its true meaning. Page 206)

19. **Why was it not time for the Lord to come?** (There were still two other messages which had to be proclaimed to fulfil the Antitype. Page 206)
20. **How did the Lord comfort the disappointed people?** (He allowed them to look within the heavenly sanctuary and catch a glimpse of the work of their Great High Priest officiating for them. Page 206)
21. **Who will answer the last trumpet call that will be sounded on this sin cursed world?** (Every child of God sleeping in the earth along with the redeemed living will answer and come forth to meet their Lord. Page 207)
22. **What will the redeemed hear Jesus say at this time?** (*“Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.”* Matthew 25:34. Page 207)
