

Review Questions

1. **To the Bible student each Levitical law is a what?** (A reflector, giving him precious rays of light from the Sun of Righteousness. Page 274)
2. **What are garments a type of?** (A type of Christ's righteousness, with which He clothes everyone whose sins are forgiven. Page 275)
3. **What reminds you of the Israelite whose entire clothing was made up of only one type of cloth?** (Those who are faithful will be given the perfect robe of Christ's righteousness. Page 275)
4. **What was the command to not plow with an ox and an ass together to remind us of?** (The ox was a clean animal and the ass was unclean. The Israelite was again reminded not to mingle the heavenly with the worldly. Page 276)
5. **The command to not be unequally yoked pertained to what two types of associations?** (The marriage relation and every business connection. Page 276)
6. **What did the command to not sow diverse seed (Deuteronomy 22:9) involve besides the obvious temporal prosperity of the farmer?** (It taught them that if they would remain true to God, they must not associate with evil companions. Page 277)
7. **What do evil stories do to a well-disposed mind?** (Evil stories corrupt the mind. Page 277)
8. **The command to build a battlement (railing) on a new house was for the obvious reason of keeping a person from falling off the roof and what spiritual lesson did it also teach?** (Every man builds his own character. It is possible to build this character to be a beacon to the world. On the other hand, like the housetop without a battlement, we may be the cause of ruin to many souls. Page 278)

9. **What spiritual lessons do we derive from the command to not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn?** (If we receive spiritual help from Christian workers, we are in turn under obligation to give them of our carnal or temporal things. Page 279)
10. **What lesson does this verse contain for the Christian worker?** (If the ox stands idly by and does not tread out any grain, then it would be proper to muzzle him. Page 280)
11. **What spiritual truth is taught by Gods healing the people who were bitten by the fiery serpents?** (All the people had to do was look upon the brazen serpent. So the sinner only has to believe on the Lord Jesus Christ to be saved. Page 281. They had to act on God's promise thus combining faith with work or action.)
