

Review Questions

1. **Who did Jacob accept as his lawful wife?** (Leah. Page 334)
2. **What is the evidence of this?** (She was buried in the family burying-place along with Jacob. Page 334)
3. **Who was Zebulun's mother?** (He was the youngest of Leah's children. Page 335)
4. **When was he born?** (While Jacob was serving Laban. Page 335)
5. **What did Jacob say in his blessing of Zebulun?** (*"Zebulun shall dwell at the haven of the sea; he shall be for a haven of ships; and his border shall be unto Zidon."* Genesis 49:13. Page 335)
6. **Where was Zebulun's land located?** (It lay between the territories of Naphtali and Issachar, bordering on the southern part of the west shore of the Sea of Galilee, and is supposed to have extended also to the shore of the Great Sea. Page 335)
7. **What is said of Zebulun as an individual or the tribe of Zebulun during the wandering or the conquest of Palestine?** (Nothing. Page 335)
8. **What does Deborah say about the tribe of Zebulun after the battle of Megiddo?** (The tribes of Zebulun were those who handled *"the pen of the writer."* This would indicate that they were a literary or artistic people. Page 335)
9. **What else was said in Deborah's song of triumph?** (Zebulun *"jeopardized their lives unto the death in the high places of the field."* God and his cause were more precious to them than their own lives or reputation. Page 335)
10. **What motive did Zebulun have in the battle of Megiddo?** (It was pure love that actuated Zebulun, for Deborah says, *"They took no gain of money."* Page 336)

11. **What Biblical examples were given of other self-supporting workers that came forward in a crisis?** (Nehemiah, Joseph and Nicodemus. Page 336)
12. **In what other crisis in the cause of God did Zebulun excel over the other tribes?** (When Saul was dead and the true hearted in Israel “*came to David to Hebron, to turn the kingdom of Saul to him, according to the word of the Lord.*” Page 336)
13. **What did Zebulun bring to this event which was more important than Zebulun’s numbers or skill?** “*They were not of double heart,*” but men the Lord could trust in a crisis. Page 337)
14. **What other distinction does Zebulun have?** (It was the childhood home of Jesus. Nazareth was situated within its borders. The people here had an opportunity of seeing and hearing more of Christ than those in any other place. Page 338)
15. **What two miracles did Jesus perform in Zebulun?** (The first miracle in Cana and the healing of the nobleman’s son. Page 338)
