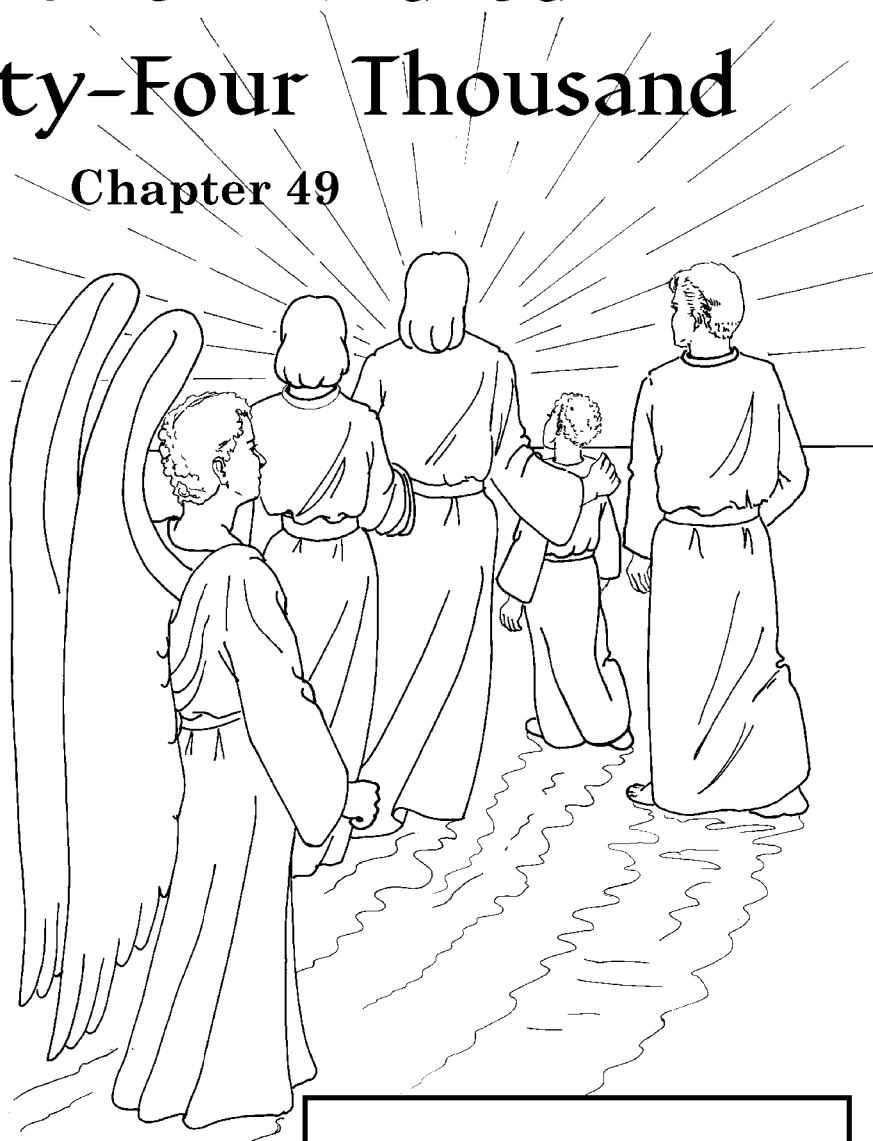

before the throne of God.”

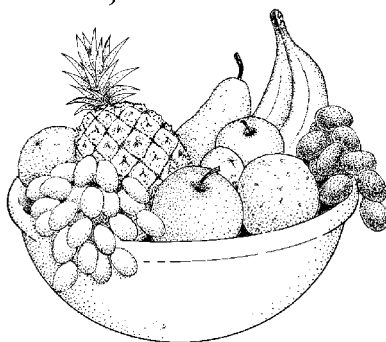
