

## **TC Mission update October 2022**

### **Temcat Mission Update:**

#### **Greetings Brothers and Sisters;**

Here we are at end of September, where I am it is starting to turn cold and trees are putting on their fancy dress of orange, reds and yellow. We thank all who remember the Mission in your prayers and share your gifts of love with so many dear souls who rejoice in the light they have never had before. May the Lord richly bless each of you, your families and friends, opening the windows of heaven and pouring out blessings in every way. Only when we see the Lord face to face, will it be fully known what your sacrificial gifts have accomplished!

#### **Teaching Seminars:**

Following Nyanga seminar the team was home for a while to tend to home mission work. Now 3 of our MMV team have gone to Mount Pleasant church by invitation of Sister Leona for a health seminar. Reports coming in that the classes there are well attended and very successful.

#### **New Groups:**

We told about the desperate water needs of the 2 new groups led by Missionaries Benson and Bruce, in the Headlands and Chiendambuya areas. TC mission decided to take a leap of faith, by paying half down and the rest to be paid as soon as we can, we hired the drilling team to place a new borehole well in each area. The Drill team did this, and for one of the boreholes, they even installed a self-pumped system, it is expensive, but durable and if it malfunctions, cheap and easy to repair, No effort just water gushing out. They said it's a sample of their new tech and installed it for us at old prices. We are thankful for this generous gift. We are seeing great results from this outreach. The Chief and people of these areas see that our God cares. The Chief asked all people to gather on a Friday night, to thank God for the water. Pastor was able to join MV Benson for this meeting. "I met with hundreds of villagers there. I taught them hygiene at the borehole. I explained to them about our God, but they had many questions, we agreed with them, that when ready, I shall return, and have a seminar with them so they could know more of our God. For the first time, to have some who never thought they would want to listen to things of God, some in polygamy, some who gave their children to fake prophets, and many other, but because we gathered at the common interest to thank God who provides water, a God they don't really know about, they were throwing random questions that made me see their need for a basis truth seminar, so I sold to them the idea of the seminar. The chief said he would back it, and that he would allow us to use a ground near his home reserved for village meetings, and they were grateful. There were testimonies how some have seen their stomach problem disappear after discarding dam water and started borehole water, they then find that they are healed. They thought it was magic, but I explained that the miracle is that God brought clean water to their door steps, the parasites from the dam which cattle drink from and pee in was actually making them sick, so therefore I encouraged them never to use carelessly the borehole or vandalize it and organize to have a fence around it and make a trench like that we did in other areas that collects spilled water into a small plastered trench so cattle and goats can drink and avoid long distance to the woods where some are lost. The village chief was very happy, rewarded me with an Ox. I humbly thanked him and asked him, to hold on to it, until I could make plans for the ox. He accepted and told me to come when I wanted it. He also mentioned that his village is so socially divided that this meeting with us was the first to have been held without fighting! Amazing!" So we were able to sell the Ox and have the money from that given to the Drilling company towards our remaining debt. We thank the Lord as this lowers the amount we still owe them, but who can put a price on the value of souls this will bring in?

#### **Bibles, Books and Blessings!**

The Mission is thankful we were able to pay off the Book Bill this month and we rejoice in all those 'Silent Preachers' of Bibles and books now in the hands of hundreds of people, many who never owned a book or saw a Bible. Hard to believe for us who have books gathering dust on our shelves!

#### **Mission Team Seminar:**

We left off with the Mission Team serving the High School and area of Nyanga. Shortly after, the team had some serious challenges in that area, which we had not expected. We actually had to deal with the worse occult situation even Pastor T ever confronted! Two persons had to be removed and taken to a safer area as their lives were in danger. But the seminar ended with 289 persons baptized from the school, and area, including the Headmaster, some of the teachers and parents of students. The area Chief came, and also said he wants baptism, but he wasn't ready. But in the next session, he wishes to be baptized.

We were able to give each a Bible and Ministry of Healing. There is such power in the Living Word of God! Praise the Lord.
