Update on Teaching Seminars:

The 3 MMVs that went to Mount Pleasant, for a health seminar, were very successful and their teaching was much appreciated. They returned home early Oct. Then all pitched in to plan a full crusade in the Mission home area, as we never had done a full effort there! We will tell the astounding ongoing story of that below!

Triumphs and Tragedies of the Melfort Crusade 16-29 October 2022.

I'm telling this in detail so you see the kind of issues the team has to face in outreach, and this one was intense indeed! This is a full crusade with Pastor Maxwell teaching organic Agriculture methods, our MMV teams teaching healthful living and healing, and Pastor T presenting evangelistic sermons in the evening. From before this started it seems it was a running battle against dark forces who didn't want it to happen. Pastor was first hit with a cough and with prayer and herbs this was healed. Next he had a bout with painful eyes making it almost impossible to be out in the wind preaching, much prayer brought healing to that also. Next on the very day the crusade was to begin, with Ps T needing to preach that evening, the entire family was afflicted with diarrhea as if they had all been poisoned! All resorted to charcoal treatments and much prayer and pleading before the Lord, and Praise His name, it had eased enough for Pastor to start the crusade on schedule evening of the 16th. Next day they were much improved, but weak. Soon all were well but the hassling took a different form. Pastor had made arrangements to use the more central local school grounds for the evening classes, where they had a generator, lighting, and a good assembly area. The first night the generator failed in the middle of the sermon and they finished in darkness. The next day the MMVs and Ps Maxwell began their day classes, and that evening all went well except the generator was placed too close to the speaker, and Pastor had to almost shout to be heard. Also a drunk sat in the back shouting 'Amen! You tell 'em Pastor!' He did no harm. Hundreds of people were attending! Next night they had moved the generator and all went well. On Sabbath all were invited to attend church and many responded.

On the 23rd and 24th things got real serious! Here's part of the account: "It was blessed but chaotic. We had to end it early, first it was the microphone, it started having unexplained problems, but we kept on praying. Then in a few minutes, a heavy wind blew, it took our projector screen down several times and deacons had to stand at the front holding it against

the wind so that it doesn't keep falling, just when they did that, fire came! Yes you heard me right, fire came, like hot coals, the wind seems to have carried those hot coals from a fire elsewhere and dropped them right among the crowd, thank God no one was hurt, but it caused disorder and people had to stand and flee the chaos, then came showers of rain, we had no choice but to end the sermon, close the machines, and dismiss the people. Just when people got up to leave, it all died down and there was total calm. So keep praying for us. Satan is very upset with the work we are doing there." What was the topic? Salvation in Jesus through faith! So he decided to preach the same the next night. We were all praying! Next night the weirdest thing took place, the meeting was quiet but then: "We were doing our service, and in the midst of our service, when I was making a call, today there were no interruptions at all, but when a man from the village, moved forward as the first person to respond to the call of giving life to Jesus, he screamed like hit by something in the back of his head, while deacons were picking him up, down from above, yeah straight down from the clouds, a huge boulder fell and crushed my Computer, it broke it, yah really badly killed my laptop! Then the man, when he got up unharmed, told us, his uncle, [who was a witch-man] his [familiar spirit] is doing it, it is angry because he is learning to pray." Pastor was greatly distressed with loss of the machine, but thankful the man was unhurt. Next day [25th] more had happen, the village man contacted the Pastor and told him that his uncle had been hit with some kind of stroke and they were taking him to hospital. There they said it was not a stroke, they did not know what it was. We all set ourselves to pray for the man and the pastors tried to visit him, the first time they were told it wasn't visiting hours, next day they did go but the man refused to see them, chased them out, just kept waving them away as he could no longer speak, only groan. Back to the 25th, Pastor had gone to town and was called that a family was at the mission waiting to see him. When he arrived they all fell on their knees pleading with Pastor to spare the uncle and husband, as they thought he was sick from a revenge attack! They even brought a little girl to give as a sacrifice for purposes we won't discuss here. They were assured pastor did no such evil as they were thinking, and had nothing to do with his being sick and were praying for him. [in fact we had not known he was sick or even heard of the guy until informed] The facts came out that the uncle, said to be a very powerful witch, had intended the rock to kill the pastor and the Lord had intervened to protect him as he had moved from the desk right when the boulder hit. Praise the Lord!! But the uncle had taken ill right then! We still all were praying the man might be spared to get a chance to seek the Lord. All was quiet at the meeting on the 26th, but "bad news came, uncle died at a shrine today towards sunset. I have no idea how he was taken from hospital to that shrine, the nephew just informed us of the sad news. Our prayers and thoughts are with their family during this difficult time." So all the meetings were peaceful since, but the news from the funeral is interesting, most of the people refused to attend it but gathered rather to the crusade. Today information was brought, "Crusade going smooth thanks for your prayers. We will be ending it tomorrow, it has been a very big job with many, many attending. People are refusing to attend the funeral, fearing for their lives, as I'm informed that a club of witches will be there mourning their fellow and bury him in their rituals too. He will be buried tomorrow." We know that we all will need to be alert and much in prayer, as there are many precious souls to be reaped here, and some very vicious enemies! But the Lord will be honoured in all this, we are sure! Pray for us as we seek to replace the crushed computer, and rejoice with us that the Pastor's life was spared!
