

Temcat Mission Update: September 2024:

Greetings Friends of the Mission;

For most of us we are soon heading into Fall. Summer seems to go quickly. I am sending this out a bit early to report more amazing events happening in the mission! Sincere gratitude to all our friends who remember this Mission in your prayers and share your gifts of love. We know the Lord will indeed bless you in many ways! Ongoing Struggle with Drought:

The devastating drought conditions still continue throughout the nation and each of our many groups are affected in various ways by it. A large part of the work at home mission now centers around renting trucks ever so often to fetch loads of free food from the relief agency, part of which feeds our family but most has to be stored but then has to be quickly distributed to others and the groups with the mission truck according to the rules of the agency and careful records kept to show their inspectors when they come around. The rental trucks and cost of fuel to distribute fall on us, but without this blessing of free relief food, many people would starve! It is not unusual for people on receiving these supplies to kneel and weep in thanks to the Lord for helping them! Here is just one Pastor's testimony; "I wish to express my gratitude to you for accepting to be used by God to be kind to us. Such help will go a long way and relieve us a lot. I am very, very grateful for that. it was heaven sent, right in time just when I did not know what to do for the first time in my life, I just knelt to pray and said Lord, I don't want to feel I made a wrong move to choose to side with the truth than stay with the conference, and just when I finished the prayer, Pastor T was on my door knocking and I cried that the way the Lord answered was so quick. I just said amen and a delivery was made! My faith grew. Amen, thank you very much."

Miracle Well Continues:

The terrible drought conditions have resulted in much prayer and some really amazing miracles. Here's one account: "To get water from our well we use a bucket and a rope tied and send down and pull to bring water out. The tin fell, and one brave man went down to get it and brought back amazing news. He says that, he noticed that there is a rock that cracked, Therefore, the crack is where the water is trickling down into the well. It is water from the rock given to all people." Many people are joining us to worship with us and everyone in the villages around seems to be aware of our miracle well never running out of water. This is really catching attention. When people ask me what happened, I just tell them, we prayed and God answered. And many now call the water miraculous and healing. Rumors continue around that some who drank from this well were cured of some stomach problems they had. [Of course because otherwise they drink dirty water!] We constantly tell people to give all credit to God and never to any part of nature or their spirit gods. We give glory to God for this. On sabbath most people no longer come to fetch water, they take twice on Friday and fill their water pots and containers to respect the sabbath. Conversations around these days is about what a Sabbath is. Even the second village people of our church, they come for water here as they don't have a well there. But the water still suffices for us all." Amen! Also report is that the Lord is sustaining the water level in the dam at Rocklands! Praise His name!

The Amazing Saga of Binga Mission:

There have been some surprising and unexpected happenings at Binga Mission with the Sabbath-keeping devil worshippers! We could hardly believe it! We were running into some of the worse occultism and devil practices of any area we ever entered and we have seen some dillies in the past! Now the amazing part of our story. Just as we expected, there started to be some hassle about our teaching things that were not in agreement with their occult beliefs! So the chief wisely called a counsel, and the one side presented that they wanted us to be sent away as they did not want their occult traditions disturbed! But there was another side, the ones who want to learn the truth and have continued coming out to the meetings, Village heads agreed that they see signs that this could be a God who has been promised by the ancestors who sent these missionaries. But they did not think He would come with new teachings that will threaten their traditional way of life. They are afraid of chasing Him away and yet failing to comprehend why he is a God who cannot work with the other gods. [actually devils] So they decided, that they will extend their village. They will allow our team to move back and do meetings near the Chaplain's house. Then those who want to, are free to move and attend, and others won't be moving there. They plan to establish a new village for the people that choose to follow this new God. It is in an area some three kilometers away from their village. Permission has been given from the chief that whoever wants to go and start building there is free to do so. Already many people are asking us to arrange the establishment of a 'God's village'. They just love having new fields and ability to own their stands." Maxwell liked it but wanted all us to advise too, when I told Ps Ereck he wrote: "Wow, wow! What an awesome God we serve!!! I don't know what to say!!! Just going on my knees and ask God to create a village of holiness that shall prevail!" Maxwell responded, "Amen. We all loved the idea. So today we are clearing ground near Chaplain's house. We start using it tomorrow with the people so that we don't interfere with the way of life there. The chief says he is with us [and he attends meetings] but will remain in his village for the sake of his people, but he will support us." Also the Lord had arranged that the Toilet the Chaplain had installed is actually in that area too! With seeing the increase in these heathen rituals and even the death of one of their Sangomas, it sure showed the seriousness of things shaping up, and truly the Lord guided and no doubt had planned this all along! When a chief does things like that, it is 'legal' for sure and the people's rights and freedom are all respected! We were all amazed! The latest is, as the drought continues all over and the heat was so bad there that they had to cut short their meetings until they could have a shelter. We were able to arrange to send a large tent, which they now have raised, after dedicating it to the Lord. This will be their church. On Sabbath the report was: "Hey, we filled the tent and worshipped together. [it holds at least 400] It was a great service and we opened the windows to allow fresh air. I thought maybe a few will show up but many enough to fill the tent were around." We are now arranging for a much needed borehole well for New Binga Village, and there will be ongoing needs for clothing and so on for those who move to New Binga Village! I believe as the Lord shows His blessing that it will prosper. We pray the people will be led to see that their nasty devil spirits don't do much actual good to them!
